What is green?

- 1 leaves catching top light will reflect the sky colour.
- 2 leaves underneath will reflect the earth
- 3 watch for reflected light from local colour.
- 4 There is usually local flower colour in it stem & leaves



Shadow Colours

Shadow's have colour as well as tone

The quality of your shadow colour can make a painting glow.

Aureolin + Cerulean BLUE

Ultramarine + Lemon yellow

Cobalt Blue + New gamboge + Permanent Rose



on yellow flowers I use its opposite. pale violet. I like Cerulean blue & permanent rose, if you don't like the granulation try Cobalt blue instead.

ON PINK Flowers

A Deep warm red would be the trick

Be careful a blue red (cold) would kill the glow.

I like crimson lake
