

PAINTING - LANDSCAPE TEXTURE.

- ① MAKE A SOFT START. IE LIGHT IN TONE.
- ② USE WET INTO WET. TRY TO REMEMBER. COOL COLOURS GO BACK. WARM COLOURS COME FORWARD. EVEN AT THIS STAGE ITS IMPORTANT. WE SET THE ATMOSPHERE HERE.
- ③ LET IT DRY - DO NOT FIDDLE.
- ④ IF ITS WORKED THEN HAVE THE COURAGE TO LET IT SPEAK FOR ITS SELF. AND LEAVE IT ALONE.
- ⑤ SORT OUT FOCAL POINT, AND FIND COMPOSITION IN THE MIDDLE DISTANCE.
- ⑥ LET IT DRY. - DO NOT FIDDLE.
- ⑦ FORGROUND. NOW YOU CAN HAVE FUN. BUT REMEMBER LESS IS MORE.
- ⑧ LET IT DRY DO NOT FIDDLE
- ⑨ PROP IT UP STAND BACK. EVERYTHING IS VIEWED BETTER GIVEN SOME DISTANCE.
- ⑩ A WHAT DID YOU LEARN. IF YOU DONT TAKE FORWARD. THE BITS YOU LIKE AND BUILD ON THEM. YOU WILL NOT IMPROVE AND GROW.
- ⑩ B DONT LOOK ON DISASTERS AS FAILURE. THEY ARE DEARLY THE MOST IMPORTANT LEARNING TOOL.
